

8/3/13- Meeting with William Kanekoa

I had a 3 1/2 hour meeting with William Kanekoa on Saturday, August 3rd, to discuss the organization of the Moiha family and land taxes. Jackie, his wife, joined us for about the last hour when she got off from work. We went over the draft organization chart and the projects outlined in the draft. William agreed with the draft model. We discussed the taxes on both the Kipahulu and Waikalua properties.

Kipahulu- \$4,726.71

According to William, the Tolentino side of the family pays for 1/2 of the taxes. The August 2013 payment will be handled by them. William mentioned Howan, John, and Sarah Tolentino as the contacts for that side.

I asked about the old agreement between tutu man and his sister and that I will need a copy of that. William acknowledge this and said he would look for the agreement and give me a copy.

Waikalua - \$4,008.70

Payment for the Waikalua property is due by August 31st 2013. Half year's payment is \$1,923.57.

I gave William ck #1255 for \$1,000.00 to help with this round of taxes. Our plan (Eric & I) is to help with tax contributions until we can get the family involved.

The Waikalua property was cared for by Albert Kike, who was known as the caretaker. William said he is the brother of Tutu lady's mother. William said Tutu lady came from a family that had money and land. The family in Hana was Kike Smith.

We discussed the Apilena side of the family and their part in the Waikalua property. William mentioned Sonny, William, and Raymond Apilena. They are Tutu lady's side of the family.

Preservation of Information

I mentioned that I will need copies of all documents so that we can share the info in a responsible manner. We spoke briefly about using the internet to reach family members. William will start looking for documents so that we can start the process.

We also spoke about filming William talking about various historical family subjects as a way to preserve the stories. Both William and Jackie agreed to me filming. Jackie mentioned that Saturdays is the best time for them. I will put a schedule together so that can start ASAP.
